Just a quick update to let you all know what's been going on here in Cusco. First of all, we JUST got internet back after close to a month due to a lightning storm that busted some equipment. Not having internet makes everything a little harder to do.

**This past month:**

- We spent a week in Limatambo an hour and a half from here helping some missionary friends with some building and getting some good hang out time with them.
- We made some contacts at a weekly joint pastors/leaders meeting and have started visiting some different churches to get to know leaders around the city. We've also been able to make contacts with some great musicians that we would like to use for various outreaches and who could possibly be involved in our future music ministry.
- We had a great visit from some friends of ours from Pennsylvania who are interested in doing missions somewhere in Peru in the near future...
- Our next door neighbor is a missionary from Canada! We had her over for lunch yesterday and she is also wanting to help us out with our ministry as she has a heart for all the foreigners living and visiting here.
- I do a lot of website stuff... I am designing a website for a missionary couple here in Cusco and am working on some partial redesigns for BCM Peru's website as well as their Spanish site which I hope to have up by next month.
- We will be team leaders in a joint venture with Commission Expeditions ([www.commissionexpeditions.org](http://www.commissionexpeditions.org)) for a month next July that will see young people from the US coming to Cusco for some hands on missions, language learning, culture and adventure. We will have them partnering with some ministries we've visited this past month to help hands on with building projects, orphanages, etc. as well as white water rafting and hiking the Inca Trail to Machu Picchu.
