Just want to send a quick update on some cool stuff happening here. As Jaime and I have been developing our ministry over the last 2 months, we have seen more doors open than we could have imagined! We have been able to refine our mission strategy, and have already started partnerships with different groups and mission organizations that will ultimately benefit both of us ministry-wise in expanding the gospel.

Jaime and I just got back today from an overnight trip to Pisac, a town a little less than an hour away from here. I was able to play drums again for an outreach concert in the town square. We were the only Christian group among 7 acts that played and we represented a ministry called "Tambo de Gozo", which among other things hosts camps and sporting events on its property there. It was cool to see people respond so positively to the music and message. God has opened some incredible doors with this ministry over the last few years and they have seen a real respect from the town in general. Amilcar, one of our friends from church does a Christian radio show for youth that's broadcast from Pisac which adds to their clout in that town.
